Our Mission is to provide a co-learning environment for emerging entrepreneurs to develop the resources, connections, and [living-systems](#) worldview needed to create thriving businesses that regenerate communities.

The Mycelium School is an eighteen-month self/enterprise incubator for 18-30 year old entrepreneurs. Participants co-create a highly customized education that will help them develop as mindful leaders, innovators and social entrepreneurs. The (un)curriculum is carried out through workshops hosted by visiting instructors, business skill development and a lived experience. These three areas culminate in the Dream Lab; nine months dedicated to the supported development of the participants' own social enterprise.

We're planning a soft launch this spring and will officially open our doors in April 2013.
